Year 9 Parents Evening Feedback 2017

Thank you for attending the Year 9 Parents information evening. We do appreciate your views so please see a summary of the feedback obtained

The evaluation of our parents evening continues to provide us with positive feedback and makes us even more aware of how our parents feel about these evenings and the benefits of them.

- **54%** of parents attended parents evening and 40 (**45%**) completed and returned evaluation forms.

| The layout of the areas used was appropriate | 97.5% Said this was true |

| The teachers were approachable and informative | 100% Said this was true |
| I felt that I could ask questions | 100% Said this was true |
| It was clear that my child's progress was important to staff | 100% Said this was true |
| It was clear guidance on how to support my child's learning | 97.5% Said this was true |

1. Is there anything that you could suggest to improve the evening?
 - Coffee
 - Stick to appointment times/Longer appointment times
 - Name cards placed higher on the table
 - Later time in the evening
 - Availability of Science/English Teachers
2. What time is most convenient for you to attend events at school?
 - Afterschool (3.30pm) 17.5%
 - Evening (After 4.30pm) 55%
 - Anytime/Didn't have a preference 27.5%
3. Would you be interested in attending any of the following?
 - 23 parents said they would be interested in attending sessions to develop their child's learning at home.
 - 15 parents stated that they would be interested in attending sessions to develop their own skills.

Future Actions:

- Review length of appointment times with teaching staff and develop a system that ensures that these are kept to where possible
- Consider options for room layout/alternative rooming for all parents evening
- Provide refreshments for parents and an area to sit down.
