

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you aware, the Welsh Government has announced that all schools in Wales will close by Friday.

Currently from tomorrow Thursday 19th March we have 30 members of staff needing to self isolate. Therefore our school is **unable to open to students from tomorrow** .

The closure of school during term time will obviously have an impact on your child's learning but in order to minimise this impact we have put in measures to ensure all students have access to learning during this time.

We have created a bank of work in Google Classroom (classroom.google.com) that covers all year groups and subject areas. All students in school have a log in to google classroom, students should be aware of their login and password details. If you need help with passwords please e-mail loginhelp@rhyhigh.co.uk and we will respond within 24 hours

In order to access the work students need to join the classroom for their year group , they should enter the following codes when they log into google classroom. A help sheet is available on our website if you need help to do this.

- Year 7 - hmjs2o2
- Year 8 - hpsrxrf
- Year 9 - jaqc7hw
- Year 10 - k6grx5o
- Year 11 - aksvpml

In addition to the work available via Google Classroom, on the school website (rhyhigh.denbighshire.sch.uk) there is a Wider Learning section that has links to documents for each subject area, stating topics students are currently studying in each year group. In addition to this there are links to learning platforms and websites to support their learning from home. Please use the same e-mail address as above for any login issues to GCSE POD, Maths Watch and Seneca.

Your child can ask their teacher for help through Google classrooms. This is done through the comment section **not the teacher's email address** .

Please keep an eye out for further updates and information via the school app, website and we will continue to communicate by SMS message and e-mail.
