I am writing to inform you that Rhyl High School will be inspected by Estyn, the education and training inspectorate for Wales from Tuesday 5th May until Friday 8th May 2026.

As part of the inspection process, Estyn invites parents and carers to share their views about the school through an online questionnaire. Your feedback is an important part of the inspection and helps inspectors understand the strengths of the school and areas for development from a parental perspective.

When completing the questionnaire, we have been advised that the back button should not be clicked on the browser once the questionnaire has been submitted as this could result in duplicate responses being recorded. I would encourage as many parents/carers to complete the survey.

To support the inspection process, Estyn will be holding a Parent Meeting on **Tuesday 5th May from 5pm to 6pm**. This will be held in the Performance Space. This will be an opportunity to hear more about the inspection process and share your views directly with the inspection team. Only parents/carers of pupils currently attending the school should attend. Unfortunately, no children of school age should attend with parents as this can sometimes be disruptive or distracting. The school will provide a room for pupils whilst this meeting is being held. Staff will be available to meet with you and direct any children to this area.

I know that many of you hold positive views about the school, and we would be incredibly grateful if you could take this opportunity to share them through the Estyn questionnaire and parent meeting. Your feedback not only supports the inspection process but also helps to celebrate the strengths of our school community.
